# Member votes generate more than £16,700 for charity at Leeds Building Society AGM

Members of Leeds Building Society have raised £16,767 for charity by casting votes as part of its annual general meeting (AGM).

The Society donated 25p for every vote returned, with members able to choose to give to either the Society's charity partner Dementia UK or Leeds Building Society Foundation.

A total of £11,806 was raised for Dementia UK, which will help more families to access help from the charity's dementia specialist Admiral Nurses, who offer clinical, emotional and practical support to enable people to live more positively with dementia.

The remaining £4,961 will go to Leeds Building Society Foundation, which focuses on providing support to those in need of a safe and secure home.

"Meeting members at our AGM and hearing about what matters to them is really important to us," said Richard Fearon, Leeds Building Society's Chief Executive Officer.

"Our commitment to charitable activity and support in our communities is intrinsic to our identity as a mutual and it's good to know our members value this too.

"Through participating in our AGM, members have raised more than £16,700 and we're very happy to pass on these donations to our charity partner Dementia UK and the Leeds Building Society Foundation to help with their valuable work."

Dementia UK is the specialist dementia nurse charity and its Admiral Nurses provide lifechanging support for families affected by all forms of dementia.
